

## ACCEPTABLE USER POLICY

Any misuse of the account will result in suspension of the account privileges and/or other disciplinary action determined by the District. Misuse shall include, but is not limited to: intentionally seeking information on, obtaining copies of, or modifying files, other data, or passwords belonging to other users; misrepresenting other users; disrupting the operation of the Network through abuse of the hardware or software; malicious use of the Network through hate mail, harassment, profanity, vulgar statements, or discriminatory remarks; extensive use for noncurriculum-related communication; illegal installation of copyrighted software; unauthorized downloading, sizing, copying, or use of licensed or copyrighted software; allowing anyone to use an account other than the account holder. Students shall not post information that could cause damage, danger, or disruption, or engage in personal attacks, including prejudicial or discriminatory attacks. Students shall not harass another person, or knowingly or recklessly post false or defamatory information about a person or organization.

The student will diligently delete old files on a daily basis from the personal server directory to avoid excessive use of server disk space. The student will NOT transfer files, shareware, or software from information services and electronic bulletin boards without staff permission.

The student may only log on and use the Network under the immediate use of a staff member and only with his/her authorized account name. The District reserves the right to log computer use and monitor fileserver space utilization by users. The District reserves the right to remove a user account on the Network to prevent further unauthorized activity.
