Dear Parents,

A small percentage (about 3%) of the budget of Fredericktown Schools is provided through Title grants from the federal government.

One of these grants provides remedial help for elementary students in the area of reading instruction. The grant provides the reading/Reading Recovery teachers and their materials and supplies.

Fredericktown Local Schools welcomes parents to be an integral part of our school program. There are opportunities for classroom involvement, Parent Conferences, Family Reading and Math nights, Parenting Classes through the guidance department and opportunities to be a part of Academic, Athletic or Music Boosters. Visitors are welcome to attend monthly School Board meetings, and parents are urged to contact any school administrator, guidance counselor, or teacher with concerns.
