7 Treasurer's Report

Expenses exceeded revenue during the month of September by \$842,409. There are several contributing factors for the increase in expenditures:

- Staff received a 2.5% base increase for the 2022-2023 school year, which began with the September 2, 2022 pay. The base increase will be approximately \$318,456 higher than FY22.
- The large expenditures during September include AEP, Gordon Food Services, Cummins Sales & Service (Control Board for Generator), McGraw Hill (Reading Wonders Grade 4), Wilson Language (Foundations Literacy K-3), Central Ohio Farmers Coop (Fuel),

Truck Sales & Service (school buses) and Zimmerman (cafeteria tables). Several of these expenditures are one-time purchases.

I am requesting an insurance moratorium or premium holiday for the months of December, 2022 and January, 2023. This is where the Board and the employees will skip a month of insurance premium with no lapse in coverage. The insurance premium will pick up in February as normal. This will save the district roughly \$180,000 per month and the employees a total of \$29, 512.70

JoAnn Ewalt, a former Fredericktown teacher provided a donation in her trust for the school district to create a scholarship fund to be called the "JoAnn P. Ewalt Memorial Scholarship Fund."

Per the trust terms, the district will receive one-half of the trust's remaining estate after all other payments have been made. When this occurs, I will be informed of the actual dollar amount of the donation.

The scholarship fund will be held and administered by the District, but the student will be selected by the Fredericktown Education Association based on parameters they develop. The scholarship can only be awarded to a student who intends to become a teacher and is studying at an accredited four-year institution. The trust does not specify the amount to be paid each year, only that it can be awarded to only one student each year.

Under ORC Section 3313.36, the Board can accept a donation or bequest like this, along with any conditions or limits placed on it, by adopting a resolution.

The proposed resolution on the agenda would accept the scholarship funds and directs the Treasurer and Superintendent to take all actions necessary to implement it.

We will contact FEA regarding the process for administering this in the future and hope to develop an annual process to ensure our students can benefit from this generous gift.

#### RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT BEQUEST

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Fredericktown Local School District ("Board") is authorized by Ohio Revised Code Section 3313.36 to accept any bequest made to it by will or may accept any gift or endowment upon the conditions and stipulations contained in the will or connected with the gift or endowment;

WHEREAS, the terms of the "William R. Ewalt and JoAnn P. Ewalt Charitable Remainder Unitrust Agreement," dated April 8, 1997 ("Trust"),

provide the following bequest:

One half [of the remaining trust estate] to the Fredericktown Local School District, 117 Columbus Road, Fredericktown, Ohio 43019, or its successor in interest. These funds shall be used to create and endow the JoAnn P. Ewalt Memorial Scholarship Fund, from which an annual scholarship may be issued to a student, chosen in the sole discretion of the Fredericktown Education Association (or its successor in interest), intending to become a teacher. The scholarship shall be awarded for study at any accredited four-year college or university, and the award parameters shall be determined in the sole discretion of the Association. WHEREAS, the Board has been advised by the representatives of the Trust estate that this bequest:

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the bequest upon the conditions and stipulations contained in the Trust;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board, that:

The Board accepts the bequest provided by the Trust Section 1. subject to the terms and conditions set forth therein.

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Section 2.

The Board hereby establishes the "JoAnn P. Ewalt Memorial Scholarship Fund" and authorizes and directs the Treasurer to create and deposit all monies received from the Trust into an appropriate fund for this particular purpose.

Section 3.

The Board further authorizes and directs the Superintendent and Treasurer to take all steps necessary to accept the bequest and administer it thereafter in accordance with the terms described herein.
