Clothing Assistance: Clients may choose 2 tops and 2 bottoms for each adult and child listed in the household. Some restrictions apply – please ask for details when using this program.

Food Pantry: A variety of wholesome, healthy food is available once every 30 days. Individuals and families receive the basic ingredients for 3 meals for 3 days = total of 9 meals. Taxable items and produce are also included when available.

Financial Aid: Assistance is available once every 6 months for those with disconnect notices on utilities. Rent assistance is also available.

Medical Assistance: ISS offers assistance for prescriptions, with the exception of pain medications, and gasoline vouchers for out-of-county medical appointments

Turn the Tide: This program provides clients with Holiday food basket and gifts; established clients may sign-up for assistance with the holidays beginning in October.

***** During the 3-week extended time away from school, we will be working with Fredericktown Local Schools to assist in providing food to the children and families of our Fredericktown community. For those who may not be able to receive transportation for the district's "Grab and Go" meals or may need additional food, please contact Interchurch for further options and assistance.**
